
# Next Generation Student Information System (NGSIS) Update - University Affairs Board

### Some Background

- Improve service and enhance the experience of students, staff and faculty through the implementation of a renewed and expanded suite of student information services (NGSIS)
- New services will be phased in over multiple years. Care must be taken to step down portions of ROSI while maintaining current service levels
- A hybrid development approach will be used to implement new applications.
- A balance of factors were considered in the delivery of new services over the past year (2012-13)




## Accessible Campus On-line Resource Network (ACORN)
