Policy on Conflict of Interest – Administrative Staff

Current Framework

- No omnibus Policy that applies to all administrative staff:
 - Non-union staff have COI referenced in employment policies
 - Unionized staff are subject to the principles but nothing is explicitly stated

New Framework

- Omnibus policy applies to all administrative staff, similar to application of existing faculty and librarian COI policies to each respective group
- Outlines responsibilities for staff, managers, and HR in managing conflicts of interest
 - Staff must disclose COI
 - Managers must work with HR to manage COI
- Supplementary Guideline being developed to provide examples of COIs, strategies on how to manage COIs, and outlines steps for making a declaration



Policy on Conflict of Interest - Administrative Staff (continued)

- Business Board approval required to remove standalone Conflict of Interest sections:
 - Policy 3.01.10 from Professional/Managerial employment policies
 - Policy 3.01.11 from Confidentials employment policies
 - Policy 3.01.13 from Senior Research Associates & Research Associates (Limited Term) employment policies
- Business Board approval to create new policy:
 - Policy on Conflict of Interest Administrative Staff
