#### **Transition Framework Highlights**

- Appointed permanent status stream librarians (appointed prior to January 01, 2024) who undergo a permanent status review prior to January 01, 2024 will do so in accordance with the criteria and procedures in the 1978 PFL.
  - Appointed permanent status stream librarians who undergo a permanent status review on or after January 01, 2024, will, by default, undergo a permanent status review in accordance with the criteria and procedures in the 1978 PFL; however, where the librarian requests, in writing, they may elect to undergo the permanent status review in accordance with the criteria and procedures in the 2024 PFL.
  - Permanent status stream librarians appointed on or after January 01, 2024, who undergo a permanent status review will be subject to the criteria and procedures in the 2024 PFL.



#### Transition Framework (Continued)

- Searches for new librarians and for department heads/senior librarian administrators commencing prior to January 01, 2024 will follow the 1978 PFL, those commencing after January 01, 2024 will follow the terms of the 2024 PFL.
- All three new Letters of Understanding will take effect on January 01, 2024.
- The five-year term for the LOUs on Research Leave or Study Leave for SPRTALS and on Secondments will commence on January 01, 2024, and end on December 31, 2028.
- Requirement to post librarian positions on the University of Toronto job posting website to be implemented by December 01, 2023.

- Fall 2023

  - ∪ of T Governance Cycle 2 December 18, 2023
  - UTL is working to have all postings on the U of T website, careers page this month.
- After Governing Council Approval
  - Publicly posted on December 21, 2023.
- Policy Effective Date: January 1, 2024
  - Exceptions in the transition framework.
  - VPFAL support for UTL through transition.
